Look up! The Airport Area is where planes zoom in to land and lift off into the clouds. Wave to the sky and see if you can spot one soaring overhead.



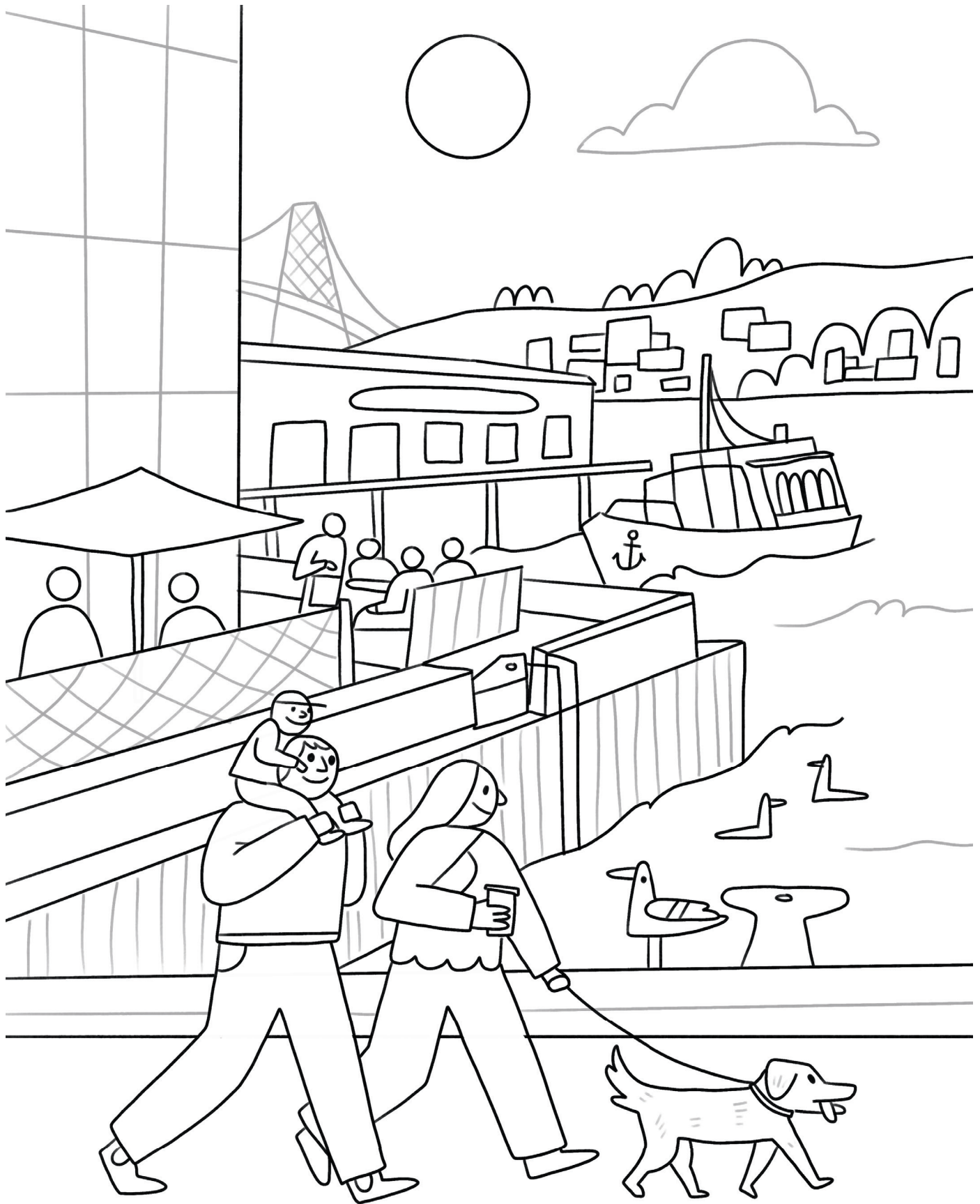
## Bedford-Sackville

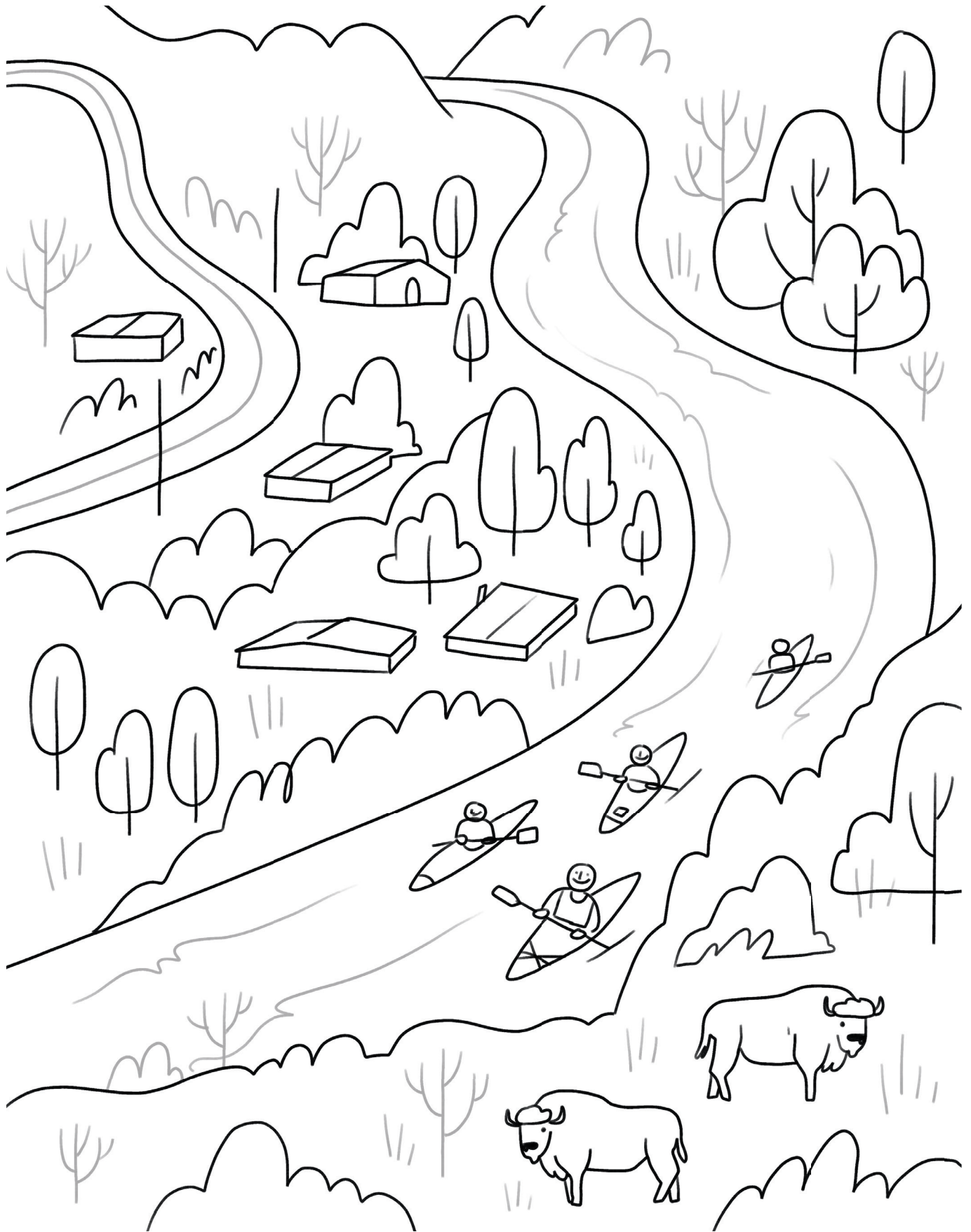
## Downtown Halifax
